VDP.GUTSWEIN

Lightness characterizes this sweet wine paired with a crisp, fresh acidity. In the nose the aromas ranges from yellow peach, over Granny Smith apple, to sun-kissed yellow lemons. The palate is sparkling, fresh and the slight sweetness allows it to gently and pleasantly slide down the palate. A wine that also lends itself well as a conclusion of a day.

Our Riesling Kabinett 2018 harmonises excellently with spicy, spicy Asian dishes, like spiced with chili. Well, it fits well on a hot summer day.

Soil: The name of the location Steinberg is derived from the very high proportion of stone in the soil. On the skeletal porphyry soils with loess overlay grow grapes that produce distinctive wines with a complex aroma and crystalline minerality. The Altenbamberger Rotenberg, a very steep vineyard, is idyllically located in the Alsenztal, a side valley of the Nahe. The name Rotenberg has its origins in the time of Rotliegendes and is characterized by sparse, stony, interspersed with rhyolite soils. His wines are extremely storable.
