Imagine the colour ‚Red‘ while thinking about the wine and you will realize that this might be a good description of the wine itself. The smell develops aroma of red berries but as well ripe peach, pink grapefruit and passion fruit. The palate shows a long finish and fresh acidity.

This late harvest is a perfect company for dates in crunchy bacon or spicy dishes. It works out as well with a nice chocolate dessert.

Soil: An amazingly steep vineyard situated in the Alsenztal – a side- valley off the Nahe, just a stone’s throw away. The vineyard’s name originates from the Permian Era – ‘Rotliegend’ soil - colourful sandstone, rugged and barren, volcanic rhyolite.
